

IMPORT AND EXPORT OF NARCOTICS-CLASSIFIED PHARMACEUTICALS

An extensive regulatory framework governs the regulation and monitoring of the import and export of pharmaceuticals to and from Sweden. Tamro holds all of the permits required to manage your administrative needs related to import and export licenses, and the reporting of data to such agencies as the Medical Products Agency, regarding your company's import and export of goods classified as narcotics.

WHY CHOOSE THIS SERVICE?

The regulatory framework governing the import and export of narcotic drugs requires a wholesaling licence for the trading of pharmaceuticals, a license for trading narcotics and another licence for being able to import and export narcotics to and from Sweden. Tamro holds all of these licences, is familiar with the Medical Products Agency's reporting requirements and has access to all import and export-related statistics within the EU. This enables us to help your company manage all of the administration related to these practices.

DESCRIPTION OF SERVICE

We require a licence granted by the Medical products agency stating that your company is permitted to engage in the trading of narcotics-classified goods. Once this licence has been secured, we need information from you regarding the substances covered by the licence and the volumes that are traded on an annual basis.

Imports to Sweden

Contact Tamro prior to the pharmaceuticals being brought into Sweden. We will apply for an import licence for that particular occasion pursuant to the information provided by you regarding the goods in question, the number of packages and the address of the exporter. We then apply for a licence from the Medical Products Agency, which will issue a valid licence for us that we subsequently send



to the requested address. Once the goods have been received by Tamro, we check the delivery against the valid licence and inform the Medical Products Agency that the incoming delivery has been made.

Exports from Sweden

When you want to export a narcotics-classified good, you or the wholesaler must send a valid import licence to Tamro. We will apply for an export licence for the goods from the Medical Products Agency. Once the licence has been granted, it will be sent to the location where Tamro is storing the good. The licence will be enclosed along with the outgoing goods and our order team will register the order with the corresponding licence number. We will also inform the Medical Products Agency about the export of the goods from Sweden and that the goods have left Tamro.

Reporting to the Medical Products Agency

Tamro will administer all reporting concerning licences, as well as the import and export of pharmaceuticals classified as narcotics for your company. The reports will be filed on a quarterly and annual basis.
