

INTRASTAT REPORTING

All companies in the EU that engage in the cross-border commerce of goods are obligated to send their VAT declarations along with the corresponding documentation for their commerce within the EU to the statistics agency in their country – a practice known as intrastate reporting. In Sweden, SCB (Statistics Sweden) gathers this data on a monthly basis. Tamro can help your company with the administration and reporting of statistics to SCB for your cross-border commerce.

DESCRIPTION OF SERVICE

In terms of the cross-border commerce of pharmaceuticals, a differentiation is made between importing and exporting between countries outside the EU, and importing and exporting between countries within the EU.

Intrastate reporting applies to commerce within the EU. These statistics are used for such purposes as calculating a country's balance of payments, and as a basis for decision-makers in the business community, organisations and government agencies. The rules for data collection are harmonised for all EU countries.

If you contract Tamro to manage your intrastate reporting, we will submit your information to SCB on behalf of your company. We will submit monthly reports to SCB regardless of whether there is anything to report or not.

Send data about your company's importing and exporting of good within the EU to us as individual invoices or as a file. The invoices or file must include information on the statistical number, net weight, value, country code and currency.
