

# REPORTING TO FTI AND SGÅ

Every company that manufactures, imports, packages or fills a good, bears an environmental responsibility and must pay a fee for the packaging materials that are brought into the Swedish market. The fee that is paid serves to fund recycling systems for these packaging materials. The materials companies FTI (Swedish recycling service for packaging materials and newspapers) and SGÅ (Swedish glass recycling service) administer such recycling systems. Tamro offers a service that covers all of the administration and payment of fees to FTI and SGÅ.

## WHY CHOOSE THIS SERVICE?

At Tamro, we have immediate access to your company's products through our distribution and warehousing services. This allows us to easily manage all of the measurement, weighing and reporting of various types of packaging materials to FTI and SGÅ. This also demonstrates that your company is taking responsibility in its environmental practices and reduces your internal workload.



## DESCRIPTION OF SERVICE

Your company joins FTI and SGÅ by acquiring a membership. Tamro subsequently acts as an agent for your company.

FTI organises and administers the recycling of packages made of plastic, metal, paper, cardboard and corrugated paper. Glass packages have their own system, SGÅ. Every month, Tamro submits data reports to FTI regarding the quantity of packaging materials your company has consumed during the period. The fees vary by material and are set by FTI and SGÅ.

Tamro pays your company's fees to FTI and SGÅ and provides you with information on what data has been reported. We will invoice you for the fees paid, and for the services that we perform. In addition to the administration and payment of fees, we can also help with the measurement and weighing of packaging materials if this data is unavailable from a particular supplier.
