

ALLOCATION OF GOODS

The re-regulation of the pharmacy market has been a large-scale and complicated process. It has created a new market with new conditions for all parties involved. As part of an effort to accommodate new needs and following discussions with the Medical Products Agency regarding the legal aspects involved, the team at Tamro has developed a service for the allocation of goods.

WHY CHOOSE THIS SERVICE?

Tamro will help you control or limit your flow of goods to customers through various types of limitations. The aim is to prevent excessive orders of goods that risk jeopardising their provision to patients.

DESCRIPTION OF SERVICE

It is only permitted to allocate pharmaceutical flows under specific conditions. This service is geared toward the following types of companies:

- Pharmaceutical companies within parallel imports, where the flow of goods via contract is geared toward certain pharmacies or pharmacy chains.
- Pharmaceutical companies that think one or several pharmacies are placing unusually large orders of certain pharmaceuticals and jeopardising their provision to patients.

The allocation of goods means that Tamro places limits on specific articles linked to specific pharmacies in our system based on your instructions. You must inform us in writing of the articles and pharmacies concerned. We will follow your instructions provided that the allocation complies with the legal requirements on controlling pharmaceutical flows.



When allocating goods, if a pharmacy exceeds their permitted ordering volume, we will send an order confirmation. This will state that the goods cannot be ordered and that the order has thus been cancelled.
